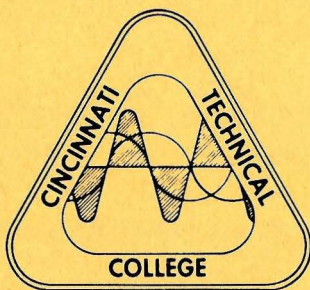

**VIRGINIA K. GRIFFIN**

**Owner and Director, Griffin Gallery of Fine Arts**

Virginia K. Griffin is a product of Cincinnati's fine educational institutions. She attended the Cincinnati public schools and has received degrees from the University of Cincinnati.

Mrs. Griffin has been actively involved in education in Cincinnati for over a decade. She has been a member of the Cincinnati Board of Education since 1968, serving as president in 1975 and vice president in 1980. In addition, Mrs. Griffin served as chairman of the Cincinnati Technical College Board of Trustee in 1972-73. The CPS board member has been involved with parents groups from Mother of Mercy Academy, Western Hills High School, Walnut Hills High School, St. Xavier High School and Academy of the Sacred Heart. She was founder and first chairperson of the Monfort Heights School District citizens committee. She also serves on the art advisory council of the Cincinnati Public Schools.

Active in community groups and projects, Mrs. Griffin is a member of the executive committee of the Program for Cincinnati; the women's committee of the Cincinnati Art Museum; Cincinnati Historical Society and the Queen City Club. She is a former chairperson of the Over-The-Rhine Task Force of the Cincinnati Model Cities Program; served thirteen years on state and local boards of the League of Women Voters; and was a board member of the Volunteer Bureau and Health Careers Association, Community Chest agencies.

Arthur R. Ehrnschwender has been a faithful employee of the Cincinnati Gas & Electric Company for 28 years, rising to the position of Vice President.

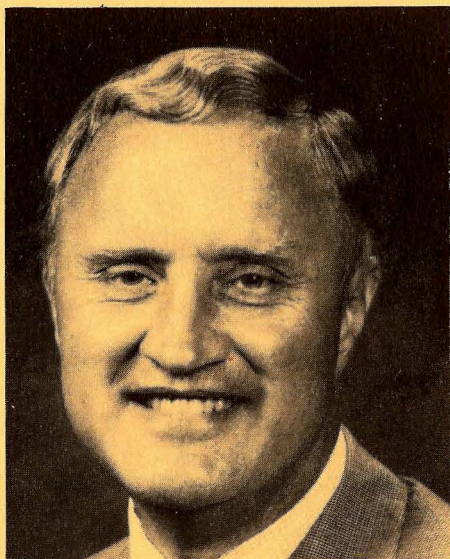
