

Owner and Director, Griffin Gallery of Fine Arts

Virginia K. Griffin is a product of Cincinnati's fine educational institutions. She attended the Cincinnati public schools and has received degrees from the University of Cincinnati.

Mrs. Griffin has been actively involved in education in Cincinnati for over a decade. She has been a member of the Cincinnati Board of Education since 1968, serving as president in 1975 and vice president in 1980. In addition, Mrs. Griffin served as chairman of the Cincinnati Technical College Board of Trustee in 1972-73. The CPS board member has been involved with parents groups from Mother of Mercy Academy, Western Hills High School, Walnut Hills High School, St. Xavier High School and Academy of the Sacred Heart. She was founder and first chairperson of the Monfort Heights School District citizens committee. She also serves on the art advisory council of the Cincinnati Public Schools.

Active in community groups and projects, Mrs. Griffin is a member of the executive committee of the Program for Cincinnati; the women's committee of the Cincinnati Art Museum; Cincinnati Historical Society and the Queen City Club. She is a former chairperson of the Over-The-Rhine Task Force of the Cincinnati Model Cities Program; served thirteen years on state and local boards of the League of Women Voters; and was a board member of the Volunteer Bureau and Health Careers Association, Community Chest agencies.

Mrs. Griffin has addressed several national groups, including the national convention of the Intercollegiate Association for Women Students, the Large School Systems Invitational Conference and the American Educational Research Association. The wife of a Cincinnati physician and mother of four children has had education papers published.

Vice President for Administrative Services, Cincinnati Gas & Electric Company


Arthur R. Ehrnschwender has been a faithful employee of the Cincinnati Gas & Electric Company for 28 years, rising to the position of Vice President.

Mr. Ehrnschwender serves on numerous educational, civic and fund raising programs. He was chairman of the Cincinnati Technical College Board of Trustees from 1970 to 1971, and has served on the College's General Advisory Committee. WILLIAM P. KOSTER

President, Metcut Research Associates, Inc.

William P. Koster is a native of New Jersey and has been a resident of the Cincinnati area since 1950. Dr. Koster is currently President of Metcut Research Associates, Inc., a materials and manufacturing engineering firm located in the Oakley section of Cincinnati.

Metcut Research Associates is one of seven hundred Cincinnati Technical College co-op employers. The company employs many of the College's engineering technology students.

Dr. Koster was educated as a mechanical engineer at Rutgers University and obtained both a Masters and Doctorate in Metallurgical Engineering from the University of Cincinnati. He has spent most of his professional life with Metcut having been responsible for the development of the metallographic laboratory and materials testing operations. His research in the field of surface integrity, studying the effects of machining and finishing operations on the properties of materials, is internationally recognized. His current position, that of managing operations at Metcut where more than one hundred people are employed, is largely administrative.

Numerous professional and service awards have been given to Dr. Koster in recent years. The Metcut President is active in several technical societies and is currently serving on the Engineers' Committee on Three Mile Island; the charter of this committee is to develop recommendations to the President and to Congress for dealing with the nuclear future of this country. Dr. Koster has just completed a term as President of SAMPE, an international organization concerned with the processing and properties of nonmetallic structural materials.

Dr. Koster and his wife, Marcia, have four sons. In addition to his professional involvement, Dr. Koster has been active in the Boy Scouts of America and the United Presbyterian Church.
