Academic Dress

From the costumes worn in the academic procession one can tell the level of degree (associate's, bachelor's, master's, doctor's) the wearer has earned, the field of learning, and the institution that granted the degree. The costume consists of cap, gown, and hood.

The usual cap is a square black mortarboard with a black tassel; the doctor's cap has a gold tassel. The gown is also normally black. Associate's, bachelor's and master's gowns are relatively plain and closed in front; the doctor's gown is cut fuller, is open in front, has velvet panels down the front, and has three velvet bars on the sleeves. The panels and bars are usually black.

The hood, patterned after the medieval monk's hood, goes over the shoulders and hangs down in back. The hoods for the three degrees vary in length from the bachelor's, the shortest, to the doctor's, the longest. The velvet border shows by its color the field of learning; the most common are: white-arts, letters, humanities (usually seen in honorary doctor's degrees); dark blue-philosophy (the most common in doctor's hoods); purple-law; scarlet-theology; green-medicine; golden yellow-science. The same colors may be used in the panels and bars of the gown. The most distinctive part of the costume is the silk lining of the hood which bears the official colors of the institution granting the degree.

The Ceremonial Mace of Cincinnati State Technical and Community College

A mace is a symbol of authority that has been used since medieval times when knights carried them in processions with their king or queen.

Over time, the mace has become an emblem of peaceful leadership and integrity. Many colleges and universities include a ceremonial mace as part of commencement and other official events.

A mace is a symbolic reminder that every institution of higher education carries out a long tradition of adding power and knowledge to the lives of those who come to learn. A mace also is a reminder that the learning process is not always comfortable or easy.

The Cincinnati State Ceremonial Mace was created in 2016 to commemorate the inauguration of Dr. Monica J. Posey as the College's sixth President. Each section of the mace represents a portion of the history and the continuing mission of the College.

Meredith Effler, MA
Professor, English

Ann Fallon, MS
Professor, Environmental Engineering Technology
Program Chair, Chemical Technology
Engineering and Information Technologies

Ann has been a member of the full-time faculty for 27 years and previously served as an adjunct instructor for four years. Her nomination recognized her commitment to student success, contributions to the College, and other contributions.

Ann is passionate about helping students succeed in class and at work, through her teaching, advising, and tutoring, both in-person and in virtual format. She continuously develops new learning opportunities for students and encourages students to build professional networks outside the classroom. She is also faculty advisor for the Student Environmental Club.

Ann took on new challenges and responsibilities as the Program Chair for the Chemical Technology (CMT) degree on top of teaching and advising responsibilities for the Environmental Engineering Technology (EVT) program. She is also the liaison to Ohio EPA (Environmental Protection Agency) for the Operator Certification Program to help students earn credit for courses required to maintain water/wastewater operator licenses. Additionally, she is a member of the Ohio Department of Higher Education (ODHE) Review Team for Engineering TAG (Transfer Assurance Guide) Courses.

Ann coordinates events like the Earth Jam (Earth Day) Celebration and High School Environmental Day, and she assists with numerous admission/recruiting events.

Ann's contributions to the College community include serving as Co-chair of the Peer Mentoring Advisory Committee, and personally mentoring two tenure-track faculty members. She also trains and provides ongoing mentoring for numerous adjunct faculty in CMT and EVT.

She represents the division on the Honors Program Committee, helps to evaluate Scholarship applicants, and is chair of the AAUP Scholarship Committee. She has served on numerous other College committees in the past.

Ann's nomination says she is "always willing to go above and beyond to help students succeed, and to promote her programs and the College."

2023 Adjunct Faculty Excellence Award Recipients:

Barbara Brown, MS, PhD - Engineering and Information Technologies

Barbara is a Cincinnati State alumnus who has been an adjunct faculty member at Cincinnati State for over 16 years. She teaches several technical courses in the Environmental Engineering Technology program including Calculations for Wastewater Operators, Operation of Wastewater Treatment Plants, Supervisory Management in Environmental Fields, and Utilities Safety and Security.

Barbara was nominated for her Commitment to Student Success and her Contributions to the Community. Her nomination described her as "sympathetic and caring toward students" and noted her excellent rapport with students, faculty colleagues, and employers who offer new co-op opportunities. Her nomination also stated that Barb is "a role model and motivator" for the students who "thoroughly enjoy" her courses. She simplifies complicated material so students can succeed in classes and in the field, and she assists students by providing tutoring outside class time, virtual learning opportunities, and exam prep review sessions. She also has incorporated materials into a course to prepare students to earn national certification for Aquatic Animal Life Support Operations, and she helps students gain hands-on lab experience to prepare for the certification exam.

Barb worked for the Metropolitan Sewer District of Greater Cincinnati for over 30 years, and she received the W.D. Sheets Award from the Ohio Water Environment Association for activities in education and outstanding accomplishments and service in preparing students for positions in the operation and design of wastewater facilities. She often serves as a judge for local science fairs, and she has published several articles for state and national trade publications.

Barb's compassion and desire to help others extends beyond the classroom: she has participated in several medical mission trips to India, assisted in recovery efforts after Hurricane Katrina, and raised \$7,000 for Ukrainian relief that she delivered to Poland, where she helped Ukrainian refugees. Her nomination stated, "Barb exemplifies faculty excellence by sharing her time, talents, and energy with others."

Don Pollock - Humanities and Sciences

Don is a full-time College staff member (Triage Coordinator for CState Accelerate) who also has served as an adjunct instructor for 10 years, and currently teaches First-Year Experience (FYE) classes. Don was nominated for his Commitment to Student Success.

Don's nomination said his commitment to students is "unparalleled" and that he is a "beloved" FYE instructor who "connects with Cincinnati State students on just about every level." As a colleague, Don regularly provides the FYE program with quality feedback that enhances the student experience and he offers suggestions that have helped to improve the program. Additionally, Don has been integral to the Black Male Initiative organization since he was a student at Cincinnati State.

Don's nomination said, "One would be hard-pressed to find another adjunct faculty member as committed to students as Don."

Kelly Wanstrath - Business Technologies

Kelly is a full-time College staff member (Greenhouse Manager for the Landscape Horticulture programs) who also has served as an adjunct instructor for 10 years, teaching courses in Greenhouse Management, Herbaceous Plants, and Interior Plantscapes.

Kelly was nominated for her Excellence in Instruction, Commitment to Student Success, and Contributions to the College. Her nomination stated that students "love her teaching style" that emphasizes active learning through hands-on experiences, and they appreciate her willingness to provide tutoring, mentoring, and other support.

In addition to her teaching, Kelly is an "unofficial leader" of the Horticulture Club who dedicates personal time to support student fundraising events. She is also a lab assistant for many horticulture classes and helps with set-up and clean-up of labs for students, as well as providing training for new adjunct instructors. Kelly also has assisted other instructors in finding student learning opportunities provided through her industry contacts in the area.

2023 Distinguished Alumni Ron Rohlfing, MBA Respiratory Care Technologies '90 V.P. of Operations, UC Health West Chester Hospital

When Ron Rohlfing moved to Cincinnati in his early 20s, he had already attended Purdue University and would do the same at the University of Cincinnati. Neither resulted in a degree. "Four-year colleges were not working for me," Ron said. Inspired by friends who worked in health care, he gave college another try at age 27 when he enrolled in Cincinnati State to study Respiratory Care Technology.

For Ron, who grew up in Indianapolis, it was like getting a green flag at the Brickyard. "At Cincinnati State, it was about applying what we learned, and that opened doors for me," Ron said. "I came to Cincinnati State with no degree. After Cincinnati State, I ended up with five degrees." In addition to an Associate of Applied Science in Respiratory Care Technology from Cincinnati State, Ron would earn two bachelor's degrees from the University of Cincinnati (Marketing and Management), an MBA from University of Phoenix, and a Master of Management Sciences from Northern Kentucky University.

He worked the whole time, starting as a student respiratory care therapist at University Hospital while still at Cincinnati State. After graduating from Cincinnati State in 1990, Ron stayed with University Hospital as a registered respiratory therapist. He has remained with the UC Health system since, as a manager of respiratory care, a process improvement project manager, director of operations for West Chester Hospital prior to its opening, and, since 2009 when West Chester welcomed its first patient, vice president of hospital operations.

"As a founding administrator, Ron was responsible for setting the culture here," said Tom Daskalakis, chief administrative officer for West Chester Hospital, which has been recognized as one of the top hospitals in Ohio by U.S. News & World Report. "Ron uses his clinical skills to help advance our focus on exceptional quality. He also leads with his heart, and that is instrumental not only within the hospital but also with our community partners." In addition to his previous community service, Ron currently serves on the Workforce Development Board for Butler, Clermont, and Warren Counties, the Butler County United Way Board, and the UC Brain Tumor Center Community Advisory Council.

2023 Student Speaker Savannah Cawood, Associate of Arts, '23 Humanities and Sciences

Savannah grew up in Cincinnati as the youngest child in a South African family of six. Raised in the country by a businessman and preschool teacher, her childhood extracurricular activities included gardening, climbing trees, and swimming in lakes. As a homeschooler, she developed a love of learning and independent study from a young age.

Savannah always dreamed of attending college, but a diagnosis of Moyamoya disease lent a new purpose to her education. While navigating treatment, she experienced immense privilege as an insured patient with connections to local specialists and vowed to help ensure that others would receive the same excellent care.

While at Cincinnati State, Savannah enjoyed studying everything from cell biology to Deaf history and medieval artists while fostering her passion for improving access to high-quality healthcare.

Savannah is thrilled to be blazing a trail as the first of her siblings to receive a college education. After graduation, she plans to pursue a bachelor's degree in public health and a graduate degree in health policy and management. Her ultimate goal is to research methods of healthcare delivery and serve as a consultant for lawmakers looking to implement effective and equitable healthcare policies.

2023 Honorary Degree Recipient Richard Weiland Cincinnati philanthropist, lobbyist, and past member, Cincinnati State Board of Trustees

Richard (Dick) Weiland was a true friend to Cincinnati State Technical & Community College. He served as a member of the Cincinnati State Board of Trustees; as government affairs advocate and lobbyist; and as one of the college's most generous donors, establishing an endowed fund in honor of Rev. Fred Shuttlesworth to support student scholarships.

Mr. Weiland generously utilized his vast network of connections to help facilitate partnerships with Cincinnati State and the community, to include Hebrew Union College and Talbert House, and he always enthusiastically participated at Cincinnati State events including 1 Night, 12 Kitchens, Scholarship Recognition dinners, and Alumni events.

He was a legendary Cincinnatian who recently passed away at age 93. At a Cincinnati State Board of Trustees meeting on Jan. 24, 2023, President Monica Posey recognized Mr. Weiland's leadership and support for the College as a board member, lobbyist, advocate, and donor. Several Trustees spoke about Mr. Weiland's impact.

Board chairperson John Silverman noted that Mr. Weiland "persuaded me to get involved in the community" and past Board chair George Vincent described Weiland as a "top advocate." Board member Cynthia Booth also spoke about Mr. Weiland's contributions to the Greater Cincinnati community and said, "he will be greatly missed."

Mr. Weiland received many accolades and acknowledgments during his life and upon his passing. A Cincinnati Enquirer article described Mr. Weiland as "a renowned Cincinnati lobbyist, power broker and philanthropist."

"Throughout his decades-long career as a political insider," the story continued, "Weiland rubbed elbows with everyone who is anyone. And he never tired of talking about who he knew. The wall of his apartment was filled with framed photographs of himself posing with presidents, celebrities, famous politicians and civil rights leaders."

'I always thought there would be a movie made about Dick,' said Phil Heimlich, a former Cincinnati City Council member and Hamilton County commissioner.

Weiland, born and raised in Avondale, graduated from Walnut Hills High School in 1947, attended Williams College in Massachusetts and obtained a law degree from the University of Cincinnati. In 1981, Weiland established Richard Consulting Corporation, which has provided lobbying services to dozens of companies and numerous nonprofit organizations.

Former Ohio Gov. Bob Taft described Weiland as "one of the leading advocates in Columbus for Cincinnati organizations and nonprofit entities."

Weiland, who in interviews labeled himself as an independent, was known for working well with both Republicans and Democrats. "I've always had friends on both sides of the aisle," Weiland told The Enquirer in 2006. "It's not about politics. It's about getting things done."

2023 Commencement Speaker Alicia Reece President, Hamilton County Board of Commissioners

Hamilton County President Alicia Reece made history as the first woman and African American to win city, state, and county offices in Hamilton County. She was appointed by then, Governor Strickland, as the first African American deputy of the Ohio tourism division where she oversaw a multimillion marketing and economic development statewide campaign. The proud Withrow high school and international studies public school and Grambling State University graduate was also elected as the President of the Ohio Legislative Black Caucus. She championed and lead the effort at the state of Ohio for the infrastructure M-L-K highway exchange.

After winning an historic county commission election during a global pandemic and a historic swearing in on January 2021, she began helping the citizens of Hamilton County with bold and innovative ideas! Commission President Alicia Reece formed the Hamilton County Covid Economic and Recovery taskforce and created a relief-a-thon helping hundreds of citizens. One of Commissioner Alicia Reece's most innovative ideas was the creation of the Hamilton County Equity & Resources Mobile Tech Bus - known as "the one stop 513 relief bus" which traveled along with Commissioner Reece to over 79 locations and 29 different zip codes to connect over four thousand Hamilton County citizens to covid vaccinations and economic assistance. But she didn't stop there! To better connect struggling small businesses to millions in grant assistance, Commissioner Reece hosted a small business relief day to help hundreds of small business owners.

Commission President Reece continues to be a champion for homeowners leading the charge for making good on a longtime county 30% property tax rebate promise to homeowners for 2022 tax year and leading the charge for the county's first \$1 million dollar senior citizen fund to assist with utilities and home repairs. As the former deputy director of the Ohio tourism division, County Commissioner Alicia Reece has utilized her creative, marketing, and visionary skills to develop and transform, what was once just rocks, into the county's largest equity and tourism project on the Ohio banks –the Cincinnati Black Music Walk of Fame— an interactive, free family friendly technology tourist attraction celebrating the untold legacy of black musical artists, producers, and musicians from Hamilton County and Southwest Ohio. This world class attraction will open July 22, 2023. In addition, Commissioner Reece also formed a regional partnership with an historic display at the Greater Cincinnati Northern Kentucky airport.

Hamilton County Commission President Alicia Reece became the first African American to give the Hamilton County 'State of the County' address in January 2023 where she championed the theme of "one Hamilton county' where everyone can afford to live, work, raise a family, retire, visit, achieve their dreams and thrive!
