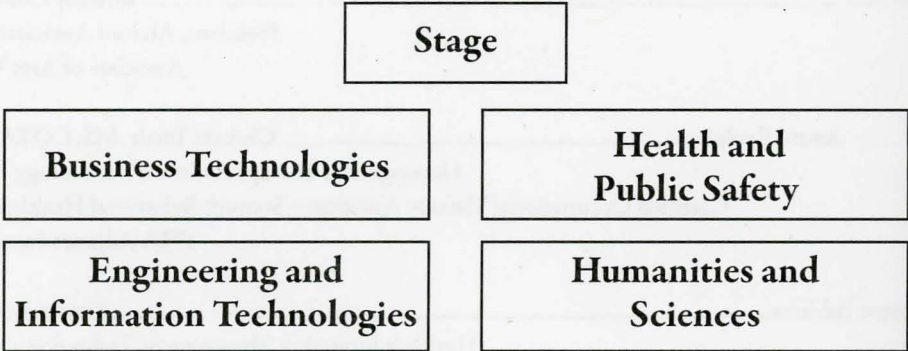

Academic Dress

From the costumes worn in the academic procession one can tell the level of degree (associate's, bachelor's, master's, doctor's) the wearer has earned, the field of learning, and the institution that granted the degree. The costume consists of cap, gown, and hood.

The usual cap is a square black mortarboard with a black tassel; the doctor's cap has a gold tassel. The gown is also normally black. Associate's, bachelor's and master's gowns are relatively plain and closed in front; the doctor's gown is cut fuller, is open in front, has velvet panels down the front, and has three velvet bars on the sleeves. The panels and bars are usually black.

The hood, patterned after the medieval monk's hood, goes over the shoulders and hangs down in back. The hoods for the three degrees vary in length from the bachelor's, the shortest, to the doctor's, the longest. The velvet border shows by its color the field of learning; the most common are: white-arts, letters, humanities (usually seen in honorary doctor's degrees); dark blue-philosophy (the most common in doctor's hoods); purple-law; scarlet-theology; green-medicine; golden yellow-science. The same colors may be used in the panels and bars of the gown. The most distinctive part of the costume is the silk lining of the hood which bears the official colors of the institution granting the degree

The Ceremonial Mace of Cincinnati State Technical and Community College

A mace is a symbol of authority that has been used since medieval times when knights carried them in processions with their king or queen.

Over time, the mace has become an emblem of peaceful leadership and integrity. Many colleges and universities include a ceremonial mace as part of commencement and other official events. A mace is a symbolic reminder that every institution of higher education carries out a long tradition of adding power and knowledge to the lives of those who come to learn. A mace also is a reminder that the learning process is not always comfortable or easy.

The Cincinnati State Ceremonial Mace was created in 2016 to commemorate the inauguration of Dr. Monica J. Posey as the College's sixth President.

Each section of the mace represents a portion of the history and the continuing mission of the College.

2024 House/Bruckmann Faculty Excellence Award Recipients:

**Kelly Hubbard, MA Ed
Humanities and Sciences**

Kelly has served as full-time faculty member for nine years and is the program chair and professor for the Early Childhood Education program. Her nomination recognized her contributions to the community and her program leadership, stating that her contributions have “exceptional breadth and quality.”

Beyond her teaching and program leadership responsibilities, Kelly is a campus leader for the Bold Beginnings in Higher Education grant, which funds curriculum enhancements to support inclusion of children with disabilities, and she facilitates student participation in the Leading Men Fellowship program, which strives to increase the number of men of color who pursue Early Childhood Education careers. She also serves on several college committees.

Kelly has helped to establish lab site partnerships with community agencies for Early Childhood Education students at the Clifton and Middletown campuses, and she strengthened a partnership with the Workforce Development Center to offer students opportunities to earn the Child Development Associate credential.

Kelly is also a recognized leader in her field at national and regional levels. She was a featured speaker at the National Association for the Education of Young Children Conference and serves as a member of the Butler County Educational Service Center Advisory Board. She serves as a subject matter expert on several review panels for the Ohio Department of Higher Education.

Jeffrey Wright, MS, FAA A&P, DME

Jeff is a 1981 graduate of the Aviation Maintenance Technology (AMT) program who has served as a full-time time faculty member for nearly 30 years and as AMT program chair since 2019. His nomination recognized his excellence in instruction, commitment to student success, and contributions to the community, and commended his “deep commitment, knowledge, and work ethic” while remaining “very approachable and willing to help any student in need.”

Jeff’s efforts as program chair have nearly doubled the number of students enrolled, making the Cincinnati State AMT program one of the ten largest in the U.S. He has helped to bring nearly \$1,000,000 in grant funding to the program. The program’s ratings for student success measures are well above college averages.

Jeff takes a key role in mentoring new full-time faculty members and adjunct instructors while also meeting the regulations required by the Federal Aviation Administration. He emphasizes a hands-on learning approach in his classes, keeping all students focused and engaged while completing meticulous tasks like taking a jet engine apart and putting it back together.

Jeff’s nomination noted that he connects with his students and graduates on a personal level because he “loves to see students succeed and help them get there—in class, in the lab, in their co-op, and in their career.”

2024 Adjunct Faculty Excellence Award Recipient:

Chanyung (James) Park, MA - Humanities and Sciences

James has been an adjunct faculty member at Cincinnati State for 12 years, teaching Sociology courses including Introduction to Sociology, Race and Ethnicity, and Social Problems, all of which he helped to develop. The Adjunct Faculty Excellence Award recognizes James' dedication to teaching excellence and invaluable role in assisting his colleagues at Cincinnati State.

James was nominated for his contributions to the college and other noteworthy accomplishments. His nomination described him as "a model colleague and college citizen" and stated "James is foundational to the integrity and success of our Sociology area and an all-around top performer."

James leads the Introduction to Sociology courses offered at several area high schools through the College Credit Plus program, and he helped to prepare materials required for Ohio Transfer 36 approval for two Sociology courses.

James also is a consultant to new colleagues by sharing model course materials and serving as the Sociology disciplinary expert for the department. He led a project to improve communication among Sociology faculty members.

Like all degree students at Cincinnati State, Christie Tuttle completed an experiential learning experience.

For Christie, an Occupational Therapy Assistant Technology (OTA) student, the experience was a clinical rotation in a health care setting, where she received guided exposure to real patients.

The setting? Summit Behavioral Healthcare, a state-run psychiatric hospital in Cincinnati that provides inpatient services to mentally ill adults referred by the county's criminal justice system.

For many people, a psychiatric hospital would be a challenging first work experience. Christie's feelings about the assignment were unequivocal. "I loved it," she said.

When Christie graduated in 1998, Summit made a job offer. She accepted and has worked at Summit ever since.

Occupational therapy assistants help patients develop, recover, improve, and maintain daily living skills. It requires a special focus for the patients Christie works with.

"My patients have committed a crime, but they may not understand what they've done," Christie said. "My focus is can they learn to problem solve, manage their anger, follow directions, attend to a task, improve their social skills. We're there to help people do the best they can with what they have, to improve the trajectory of their life."

"I believe there isn't a person you wouldn't love if you knew their story."

Such work alone would be a meaningful and rewarding career. But Christie's passion for OTA would include further education, teaching, and leadership for the OTA profession.

After earning a bachelor's degree in Applied General Sciences at University of Cincinnati in 2005, she became an adjunct Instructor in Cincinnati State's OTA program, a position she has held since. In 2023, she also began teaching a mental health course in the OTA program at Muskingum University in New Concord, Ohio.

Greg Landsman

United States Representative, Ohio District 1

Representative Greg Landsman is a father and husband who is proud to call Southwest Ohio home.

Before joining the U.S. House of Representatives in 2023, Greg served on the Cincinnati City Council for five years where he led investments in public safety and core services. “

Greg also led the effort to establish the City of Cincinnati’s first-ever Office of Ethics and Good Government as well as the Balanced Development Scorecard to increase trust in local government and transparency in the development process.

Greg has spent his entire career advocating for children and families, especially those most marginalized.

Prior to his time in elected office, Greg was a public-school teacher and worked in education advocacy as the executive director of the Strive Partnership.

Greg also served as the director of Faith-based and Community Initiatives under former Ohio Governor Ted Strickland. There, he led Ohio’s efforts to help local churches and synagogues provide education and food programs in their communities.

A pragmatic leader, Greg has a long history of working with broad, bipartisan coalitions to get good, meaningful things done.

In 2016, Greg led a successful ballot measure to pass the Cincinnati Preschool Promise, a program which provides two years of quality preschool education for every three- and four-year-old in Cincinnati.

In 2018, he built a coalition of Democrats, Republicans, labor organizations, business leaders, and community members to pass the largest investment in transportation and infrastructure in Hamilton County’s history.
