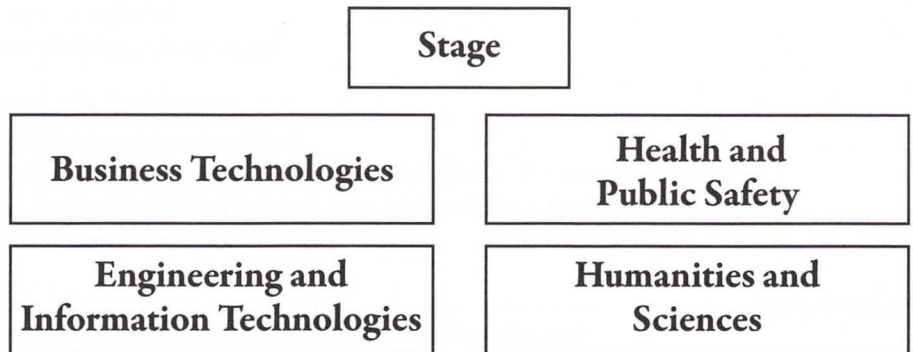

Academic Dress

From the costumes worn in the academic procession one can tell the level of degree (associate's, bachelor's, master's, doctor's) the wearer has earned, the field of learning, and the institution that granted the degree. The costume consists of cap, gown, and hood.

The usual cap is a square black mortarboard with a black tassel; the doctor's cap has a gold tassel. The gown is also normally black. Associate's, bachelor's and master's gowns are relatively plain and closed in front; the doctor's gown is cut fuller, is open in front, has velvet panels down the front, and has three velvet bars on the sleeves. The panels and bars are usually black.

The hood, patterned after the medieval monk's hood, goes over the shoulders and hangs down in back. The hoods for the three degrees vary in length from the bachelor's, the shortest, to the doctor's, the longest. The velvet border shows by its color the field of learning; the most common are: white-arts, letters, humanities (usually seen in honorary doctor's degrees); dark blue-philosophy (the most common in doctor's hoods); purple-law; scarlet-theology; green-medicine; golden yellow-science. The same colors may be used in the panels and bars of the gown. The most distinctive part of the costume is the silk lining of the hood which bears the official colors of the institution granting the degree.

The Ceremonial Mace of Cincinnati State Technical and Community College

A mace is a symbol of authority that has been used since medieval times when knights carried them in processions with their king or queen.

Over time, the mace has become an emblem of peaceful leadership and integrity. Many colleges and universities include a ceremonial mace as part of commencement and other official events. A mace is a symbolic reminder that every institution of higher education carries out a long tradition of adding power and knowledge to the lives of those who come to learn. A mace also is a reminder that the learning process is not always comfortable or easy.

The Cincinnati State Ceremonial Mace was created in 2016 to commemorate the inauguration of Dr. Monica J. Posey as the College's sixth President. Each section of the mace represents a portion of the history and the continuing mission of the College.

Dr. Hatchett has been a faculty member since 2010, and she received the House/Bruckmann Award in 2015. Her nomination this year recognized her Collaborative Spirit and recent Contributions to the College, including leading projects for the College Credit Plus (CCP) Committee to create more efficient and effective programming for high school students who are completing college coursework at Cincinnati State. She led the creation of guidance documents for CCP coordinators college-wide and worked with administrators and faculty to rewrite the guidelines for relationships between Cincinnati State and participating CCP high schools.

Heather also provided research, vision and tireless effort to assist the College in securing a \$2 million Federal Title III grant to create the CState Complete program, which supports student success by preventing students from “stopping out” of college, and helps these students complete their degree. She serves as Faculty Champion for CState Complete, providing leadership to the faculty advisory team and working with the program staff to gather and analyze data and report invaluable insights about student and faculty needs.

Her nomination noted that Heather offers “unwavering commitment to collaboration with colleagues,” along with “willingness to share her expertise and experiences as a trusted resource,” and “dedication to the success of students and faculty.”

Professor Smith has been a member of the faculty since 2009. Her nomination for the House/Bruckmann Award recognized her Contributions to the College and Collaborative Spirit, including active participation in governance groups that affect many aspects of College operations, such as the Academic Policies and Curriculum Committee, the Academic Calendar Committee, and the Safety Committee. Paula also has served as Vice President of the Cincinnati State Chapter of the American Association of University. Her nomination described her work in these groups as “a staunch advocate for reform, improvement, and employee and student advocacy” and said she demonstrates “commitment to excellence, equity, and understanding.”

Her nomination also stated that Paula’s “constant nudging of Cincinnati State in the right direction has had significant and lasting impact,” and noted that her collaborative spirit often is focused on the College’s longterm success, such as contributions to development of student-centered language for several College policies, and serving as a driving force in building faculty and student camaraderie. The nomination commended Paula’s work as both an official and unofficial mentor to many other fulltime and adjunct faculty members.

His nomination said Ray's passion for teaching and commitment to student success make him a standout educator who effectively combines theoretical concepts with real-world applications. He fosters interactive learning environments where students feel comfortable asking questions, experimenting, and developing critical problem-solving skills. He applies varied teaching tools including simulations and case studies that connect to students' interests and help them grasp complex topics.

Ray's nomination said "he ensures that every student is engaged and challenged," by providing one-on-one support for students struggling with complex concepts and by pushing high achievers to explore more advanced material. Ray also serves as a mentor, guiding students through their academic journeys and offering valuable career advice. Manuel Chavez III
CEO, Mobile Infrastructure Corporation

It was spring 1999, and Manuel Chavez III had just graduated from Miami University with a Bachelor of Arts in English Literature. He considered enrolling in law school or pursuing an MBA. “My dad, one of the wisest guys in the world, said ‘while you decide, why don’t you come and work for myself and your uncles,’” Chavez remembered.

He took his dad’s advice. “I got hooked immediately,” he said about working at PCA Inc. and Chavez Properties, the family-owned parking and real estate companies that today employ more than 1,100 in markets across the country. Starting in operations, he rose to become CEO, responsible for all subsidiaries, business development, and financing activities.

In 2017, Chavez struck out on his own as founder and managing partner of Bombe Asset Management. In 2021, he also became CEO of publicly traded Mobile Infrastructure Corp., overseeing more than \$1 billion in real estate investments. “I really enjoy solving the puzzle of real estate transactions” he said, “not only creating a win-win for our company and clients but also finding the best and highest use for the community.”

Dr. Monica Posey, president of Cincinnati State, said “Manuel is truly a great person and his accomplishments in business and public service are amazing. We appreciate how he has supported Cincinnati State over many years and in many different ways, enhancing our ability to positively impact Greater Cincinnati.”

Former Cincinnati Mayor John Cranley said, “Manuel is a lifelong Cincinnati who has demonstrated his commitment to our community. As a successful businessman, he has created jobs and expanded opportunities in our region. He has never shied away from giving his time to the community, including to the Port Authority, to which I appointed him. I am proud to call him a friend.”

Chavez has contributed his time to multiple nonprofits, including the Music Hall Revitalization Co., which led the \$143 million renovation of the historic venue. He now focuses on the Port, and on Cincinnati State, where he served on the Foundation Board and for the past eight years, on the Board of Trustees. “It’s a great combination,” he said. “The Port gets real estate ready for job creation and Cincinnati State trains the workforce to fill the need.”

Asked about hobbies, he laughed. “At this time of life, it’s work and kids. I wouldn’t have it any other way.”

2025 Commencement Speaker

Aftab Pureval, JD Mayor of Cincinnati

Aftab Pureval is the 70th Mayor of Cincinnati, and the city's first Asian American Mayor.

Mayor Pureval was raised in Southwest, Ohio, the son of first-generation Americans. He graduated from The Ohio State University in 2005 followed by the University of Cincinnati College of Law in 2008, where he was an editor at UC Law Review.

Before entering politics, Mayor Pureval worked as an associate for a law firm in Washington, D.C., as a special assistant U.S. attorney for the United States Department of Justice, and as a global brand attorney for The Procter & Gamble Company.

He served as Hamilton County Clerk of Courts from 2016 to 2021. During his tenure, he brought modern and professional reforms to the Clerk's office. He paid a living wage to all employees and became the first county officeholder in Ohio to offer comprehensive paid family leave.

As Mayor, he is committed to serving Cincinnati's 52 neighborhoods. He has made equitable economic growth a top priority of his administration, as well as a comprehensive reform and improvement of public safety, affordable housing, and environmental action.

Mayor Pureval resides in Clifton with his wife, Whitney, and their sons, Bodhi and Rami.
